Al Catz Hawaii Report

Hi! Once again, Al Catz, exonumia collector, reporting from Hawaii. An unlisted Hawaiian encased has surfaced! Actually, the piece, after reviewing Medcalf & Russell's Hawaiian Money book, is a variant of 2EN-49, L.H. Wong's Auto Repair, and is at the same location (3075 Waialae Ave.) with similar, but nonetheless slightly different phone number than on the L.H. Wong piece. My guess is that Mr. Wong sold the establishment (or may have passed away), and the subsequent owners renamed the shop and continued his method of advertising....by way of the encased coinage; since there was a change of phone number. perhaps my former thought of his selling the business is correct, as he retained the original number for his own use. Also, possible, this new piece is unique...a sample for Oahu Service and Repair to determine if they wanted to continue the encased

coinage for their own advertising purposes (but decided against the idea). 2EN-49 catalogs for \$30.00 (Note: The author "bid"over double this price to acquire the new discovery...it sold for slightly over my offer).

As for other encased that have I picked up locally of late (it always fascinates me how they've found their way onto the islands!): A well-worn, but readable, round 1901 encased, that reads. Use Dearborn Boiler Compounds....Little Savings Make Big Dividends (small letters)..."Clean Boilers"// KMAAHM. I liked the piece, although I don't often purchase encased that are this well-worn. And one other acquisition: 38mm round Lewis & Clark Exposition, Souvenir, Portland, Ore., from 1905....A Good (S)cent on Fortune/Keep Me/Be Lucky/Never Guilty when In-A-Cent! This is a "fun" piece that I may or may not already have among my holdings; however, the price was right (I thought), and the overall condition is quite acceptable, with the cent being brown XF-AU, and the encasement relatively mark-free, although a bit mottled in color.

New Shape Reported for ACE

from Al Weinberg

Al writes, Terry Hess of Clemmons, NC, a knowledgeable, longtime numismatist reports to me that he recently examined an old encased cent in a ballerinashaped encasement. Something I've not heard of in 45 years in the hobby.

A word about National Lead from Jim Lawniczak

The encased, National Lead Co./ Anti Friction/ Babbitt Medals/ Perfection// Good Luck/ Keep Me and Prosper. Round, 38mm, 1901 cent. I have heard that the National Lead Co. had an exhibit at the 1901 Buffalo Pan American Exposition and these were given out there, but there is nothing about the fair on the encasement.

Suggested Catalog System for Souvenir pieces and Expositions

from Jim Lawniczak and Bryan Ryker

The proper catalog method for the Souvenir series would be "sv". The first in the series for Washington D.C. would be DC-WAS-SV-10, for example. This then would match the other catalog numbers. The exposition series should be noted by an X. PX (for Pan American Exposition, instead of Pae) What do ACE members think?

Encased Radioactive Dime by Tom Casper

Most collectors of encased probably have a radioactive dime from the American Museum of Atomic Energy. The dimes, although common, are interesting because of the way they are encased. But what isn't common is the card the dimes were attached to. The card is blue with the orbits and printing on the bottom in red. The photocopy did not print well. It

reads. Production of Radioactive Silver 110. The encased dime is pictured with the orbits drawn around the pictured encasement. The encasement is about 26mm and reads: American Museum of Atomic Energy-Neutron Irradiated. Most have blue or black lettering with the reverse being a backing of aluminum and the front is covered with plastic. Late date Mercury dimes and silver Roosevelt dimes are usually the kind that exist. On the card it further states: "This dime has been made radioactive by neutron bombardment. Radioactive silver 110 has a half life of 22 seconds. Upon decay, the silver 110 becomes cadmium 110. The Beta Radiation from this dime is so slight. There is no danger of injury." Near the bottom of the card it reads, "American Museum of Atomic Energy, P.O. Box 117, Oak Ridge, Tennessee. Operated for the United States atomic energy commission by the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies."

Jim Lawnizak makes mention of another type in his recent price list, he writes: N.Y. World's Fair 1964 1965/ Neutron Irradiated dime, round, 45mm. Blue plastic with a 1964 dime slotted in. Supposedly, these dimes were "Neutron Irradiated" at the fair, and thus would react positively to a Geiger Counter.

Fankhauser Fun by Bryan Ryker

Every year at Christmas during the late 1960s and early 1970s Earl Fankhauser's wife, Audrie, would put together a newsletter called <u>Family Fun</u>. In it she would capture a story from each child and grandchild and send a copy to all the family.

Borrowing a bit from Audrie, this is the first edition of Fankhauser Fun, a regular column featuring stories and new information on Fankhauser encased coins. For this quarter's edition I'd like to share a story that comes from Jim Lawniczak.

Jim is cataloging all encased from Ohio. He was puzzled by two Clover Leaf Plastics pieces, OH-MAN-CL-10 from Mansfield and OH-WMA-CL-10 from West Mansfield. One might think that West Mansfield would be just west of Mansfield. But it turns out West Mansfield is 60 miles away. Then he noticed that the two pieces advertised the same PO box and address - "Box 154 - 323 Park Ave. W."

The more he thought about it the less likely it seemed that Clover Leaf Plastics was in both towns. So he decided to doublecheck his pieces. Turns out he had two of the West Mansfield piece, a worn one and an uncirculated one. Looking closer he discovered that someone had taken a punch and flattened out the "W" on the worn piece, trying to erase it!

From this he has concluded that the "W" on the West Mansfield piece is an error. The pieces that were delivered to Clover Leaf Plastics were "corrected" either by Fankhauser or someone at Clover Leaf Plastics. Apparently the company was unhappy with the solution, and so the second piece was made with the same date coin (1962D) and wording except for the "W".

If you have a story to share, or any new discoveries or questions about Fankhauser encased, drop me a line. It's what makes this hobby fun!

It's hard to believe that in the three years since publishing my catalog of Fankhauser encased coins not a single "new" piece has been discovered. Just a month before going to press our chief frog, Joel Reznick, found two pieces I didn't know of. There must be more out there!

Note to member auction consignors: Starting with issue 14 and all subsequent member auctions until further notice a 5% charge will be added to all consignments. The income from the 5% will go toward auction expenses, such as postage cost for mailing invoices, copying charges, padded envelopes for mailing winning lots, 2x2's, etc. Any additional income generated by the consignment charge will go into the club treasury. Note to member auction consignors (con't)

A\$1.00 each, postage is \$.55 and the envelope for mailing is \$.08. This then translates into \$6.52 a year for four issues. However, if an issue is more then 28 pages postage cost jumps to \$.78, printing to \$1.15 plus pending number of pages and mailing envelopes are \$.08 each. Cost for 4 issues now becomes \$8.04. The size of the auction contributes to the number of pages in the issue which in turn contributes to overall cost.

As for the auction, it is a popular section for about 1/4 of the membership. Each sale averages about 5 consignments and about 30 to 35 members place bids. The auction offers members a way to sell extras and provides members with a source to obtain encasements. It is a worthwhile section for many members and because of this it will remain a regular section in The Casement.


